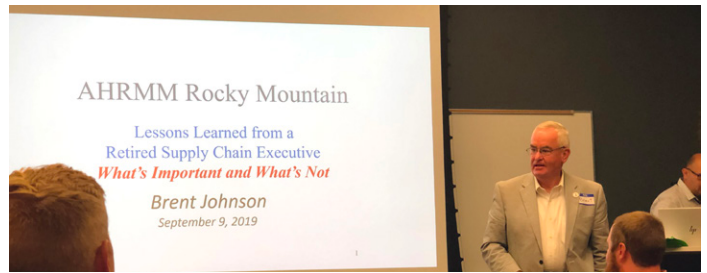
FALL CONFERENCE
